Project Goals:

1. Remove table from kitchen and create informal eating area connected to island.
2. Remove corner pantry and replace with refrigerator. Add new cabinet pantry with built-in microwave where old refrigerator used to be.
3. Replace flooring throughout main floor.
4. Updated bathroom cabinetry, lighting and counters.

Directions: Go south on Cty. Rd. 22; turn left on 7th Street NW; take 1st right onto Lakeridge Place NW; Lakeridge Place becomes Lakeridge Lane NW; house is at the end of the cul-de-sac. End at 3202 Lakeridge Lane NW.

This home is only about 10 years old. Many of the existing finishes were of entry level quality and did not fit the personal style of the homeowner. The general footprint of the kitchen did not change much, however cabinetry now runs to the ceiling and provides better functionality within each cabinet. New two tier island was added, a hood that creates a focal point for the kitchen and stone fireplace wall with built-in cabinetry are features to note. The opening to new formal dining was extended and arched for added detail. New lighting was also added throughout the space. Now the homeowner can still enjoy the beautiful view and in town location with new home features.
